Biography

Jay Prag is the Clinical Associate Professor at the Peter F. Drucker and Masatoshi Ito Graduate School of Management in the Claremont Graduate University. Dr. Prag’s areas of expertise include Corporate Finance, Investments, Economics of Strategy, and Macroeconomics. His current research interests focus on Not-for-Profit Finance and Economics, and Corporate Culture and Valuation.

Professor Prag has been teaching at the Drucker School since 1986. He also teaches at Harvey Mudd College. He recently served on the Board of Directors of Mount San Antonio Gardens, a large nonprofit retirement community in Claremont. He has also been actively involved in several start-ups. Professor Prag has won several teaching awards in his years at the Claremont Consortium, and in 2009 received “Best Professor” honors from the MBA, EMBA and Financial Engineering graduating classes at the Drucker School. He also teaches financial analysis in the Executive Leadership Potential program at Southern California Edison.

Professor Prag received his doctorate from University of Rochester, Masters degrees from University of Rochester and University of Florida, and a bachelor degree in business administration from University of Florida.
